Steven Henry retired from the Bristol Borough Police Department after serving six years as Chief of Police. Prior to that, he was the Corporate Security Director for New Jersey Resources. Before his corporate career, Chief Henry served with the Toms River Police Department for twenty-eight years and retired at the rank of captain.

Chief Henry's tenure encompassed all aspects of law enforcement, including patrol operations, SWAT, criminal investigations, narcotic investigations, and professional standards.
